Clue #2 – “Heaven & Earth”

Granny is still looking for her glasses. It’s really difficult searching for them, when you can’t see what you’re doing in the first place! She decides she will move heaven & earth if she has to in order to find them. Where are Granny’s Half Moons???

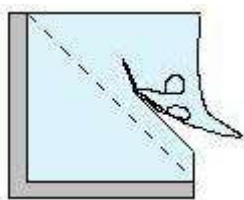
This installment involves making two different blocks named “Heaven” and “Earth”. You will need to make 8 “Heaven” blocks and 8 “Earth” blocks.

Block 1 – “Heaven”

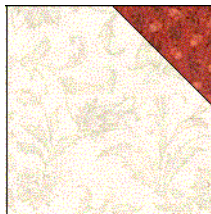
Cutting Instructions (for all 8 blocks)

Color #1 Background	Cut 64 – 2 ½” Squares
Color #4 Yellow	Cut 8 – 2 1/2” Square
Color #5 Red	Cut 32 – 1 ½” Squares Mark on the Diagonal (wrong side)

Assembly:

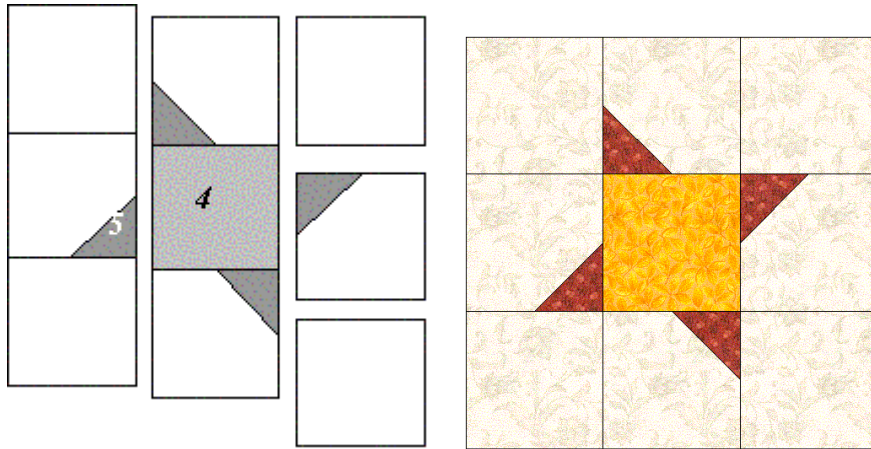


Quick Corner Method: Place a #5 Red square in one corner of a background square. Place the diagonal line you marked as shown on the left. Stitch ON THAT LINE. Trim away the corner approximately ¼” from that line as shown. Flip back and press. Repeat for the other background/red squares.



Make 32

Now assemble your blocks like any 9-patch, in 3 rows of 3 units, with #4 yellow square in the center: Your blocks should measure 6 1/2".



Make 8

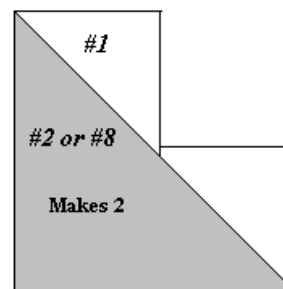
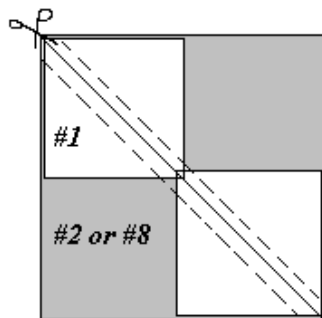
Block 2 – “Earth”

Cutting Instructions (for all 8 blocks):

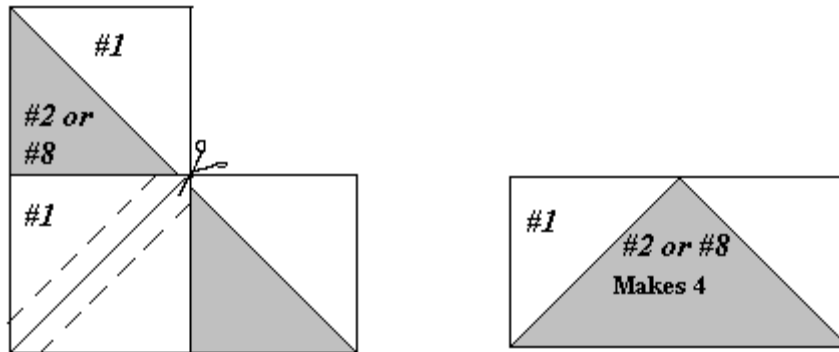
Color #1 Background	Cut 16 - 1 1/2" x 2" Rectangles Cut 16 - 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" Rectangles	Cut 16 - 2 7/8" Squares
Color #2 Lt. Green	Cut 2 - 5 1/4" Squares Cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles	
Color #8 Dk. Green	Cut 2 - 5 1/4" Squares Cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles	
Color #10 Dk. Brown	Cut 8 - 1 1/2" Squares	

Assembly:

Begin by making your *No-waste Flying Geese* units for the trees. Place two background squares in opposite corners of a large green square (right sides together) (pin in place if you need to). Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner as illustrated, stitch a scant 1/4" seam on both sides of that line, and cut apart—yielding 2 units. Press toward the green.



Now place a background square as shown, draw the line across, and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides again. Cut apart and press towards the green. Repeat for the 2nd unit. VOILA! 4 Flying Geese Units! Repeat this for the remaining green $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. You should have 8 units each Lt. Green and Dark Green, and they should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Assemble your blocks as shown below. Alternate grass and tree colors. Stitch your two flying geese units together first, then the background/trunk pieces. Stitch trunk unit to tree unit. Add side background pieces, then the grass. Your blocks should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. You will have 4 blocks of each color.
