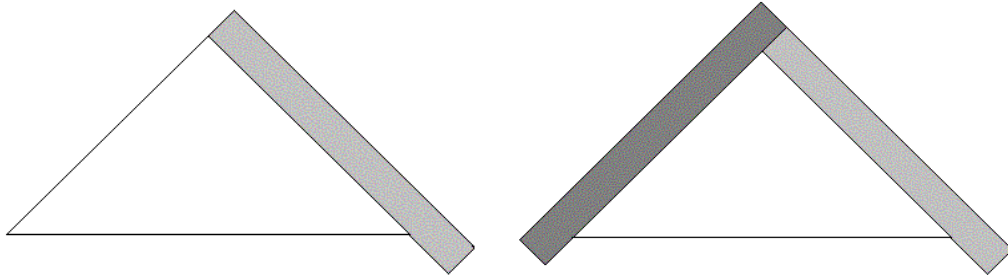
Cutting Instructions (for all 4 blocks):

Color #1 Background	Cut 2 – 8 7/8” Squares, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 16 – 1 ½” x 14” Rectangles
Color #2 Lt. Green	Cut 1 – 5 7/8” Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangle
Color #3 Blue	Cut 1 – 5 7/8” Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangle
Color #5 Red	Cut 1 – 5 7/8” Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangle
Color #7 Purple	Cut 2 – 5 7/8” Squares, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 2 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangles
Color #8 Dk. Green	Cut 1 – 5 7/8” Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangle
Color #9 Lt. Brown	Cut 1 – 5 7/8” Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangle
Color #10 Dk. Brown	Cut 1 – 5 7/8” Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal	Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 12” Rectangle

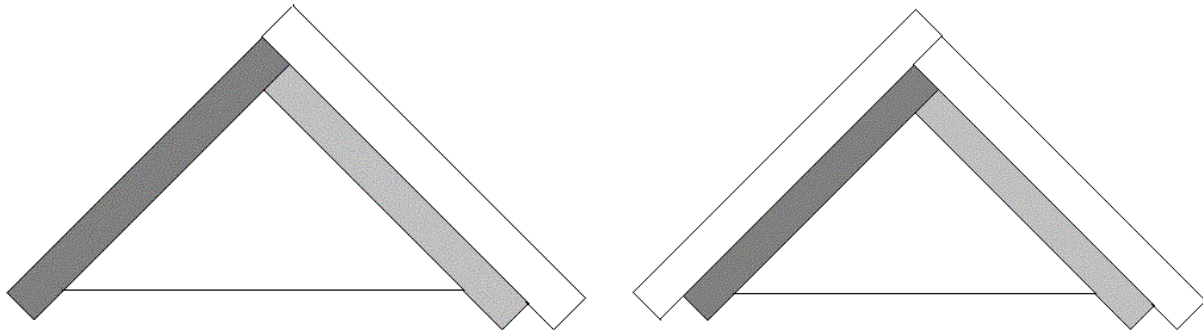
Assembly:

You will be making 4 “satchels” -- One #5Red/#7Purple – One #2Blue/#8Dk. Green – One #7Purple/Lt. Green – and One #9Lt. Brown/#10Dk. Brown.

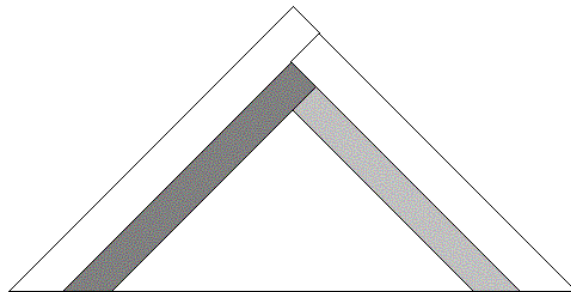
Begin piecing with a background triangle. Add a light 12” rectangle to the side of the triangle as shown on the next page. Press back. Then stitch a second color strip to the opposite side of the triangle: (Always start your stitching at the top of the triangle). Press back.



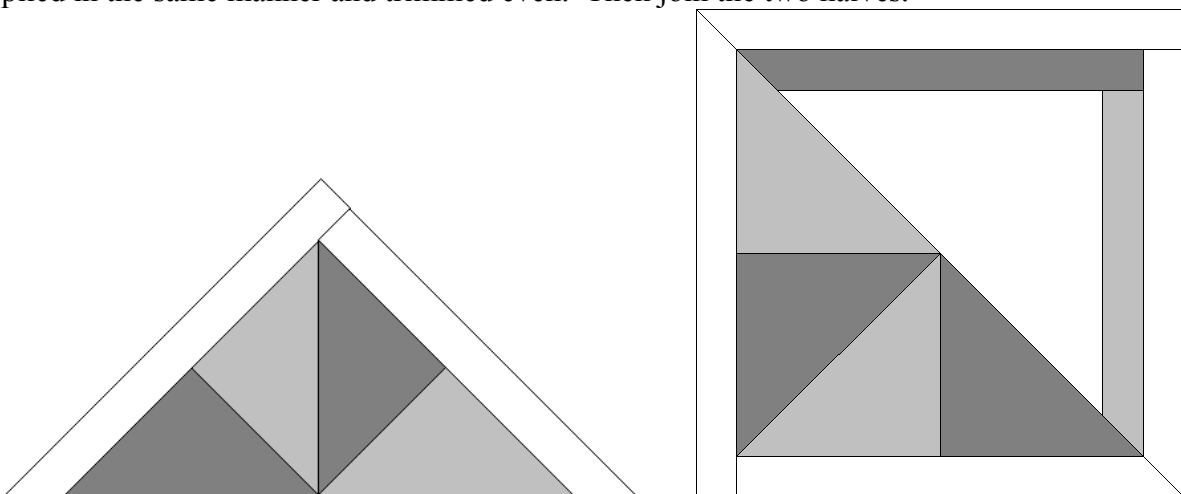
Repeat the same process with two background strips: (Press towards satchel handle).



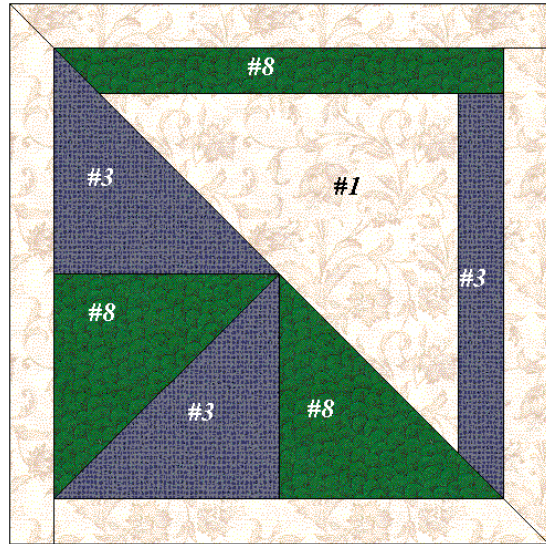
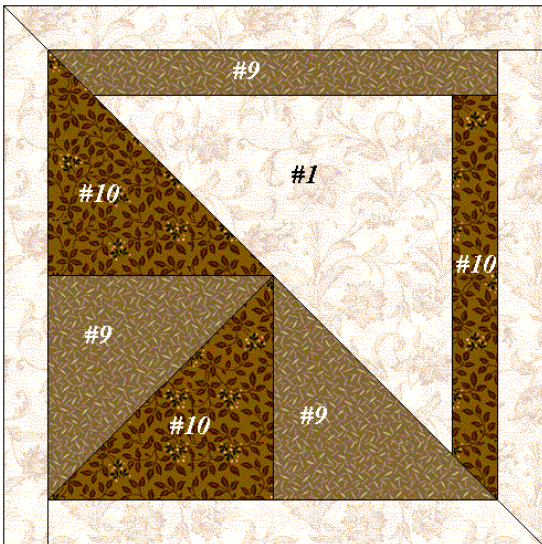
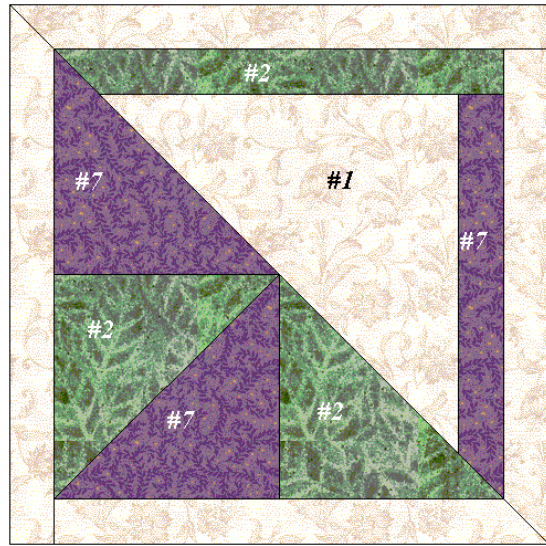
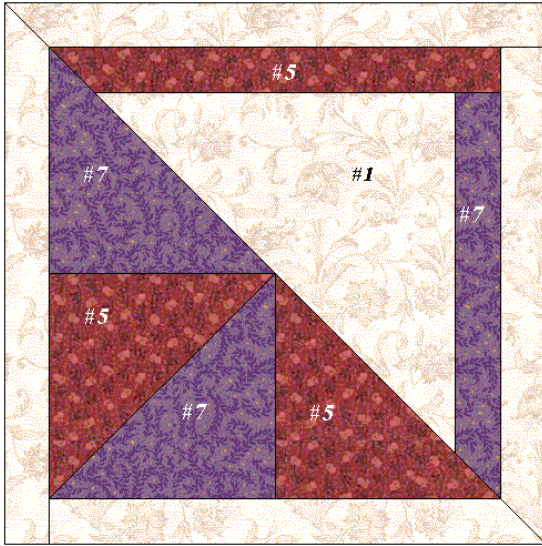
Now simply trim the unit even with the bottom of the background triangle.



The second half of the block is pieced with the two colors as shown, then the background strips applied in the same manner and trimmed even. Then join the two halves.
