Cutting Instructions (for all 12 blocks):

Color #1 Background	Cut 12 – 2 ½” x 4 ½” Rectangles Cut 12 – 2 ½” x 6 ½” Rectangles	Cut 12 – 2 ½” x 8 ½” Rectangles Cut 12 – 2 ½” x 10 ½” Rectangles
Color #2 Lt. Green	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 6 ½” Rectangles	
Color #3 Blue	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 12 ½” Rectangles	
Color #5 Red	Cut 12 – 4 ½” Squares Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 10 ½” Rectangles	
Color #6 Gray	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 12 ½” Rectangles	
Color #7 Purple	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 10 ½” Rectangles	
Color #8 Dk. Green	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 6 ½” Rectangles	
Color #9 Lt. Brown	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 8 ½” Rectangles	
Color #10 Dk. Brown	Cut 6 – 2 ½” x 8 ½” Rectangles	

Assembly:

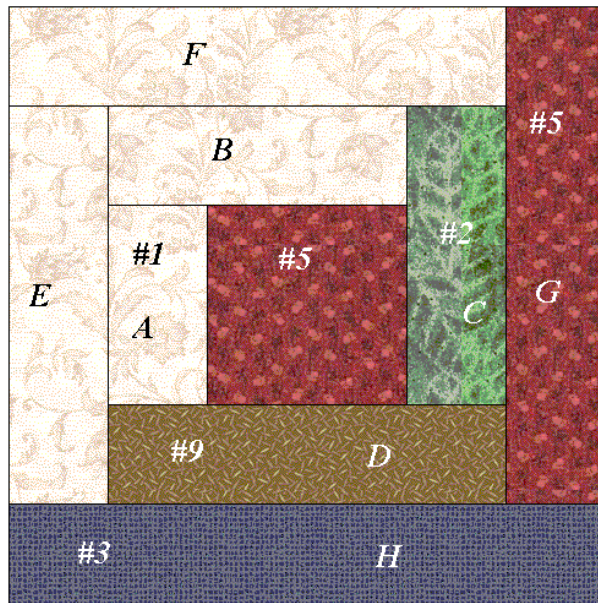
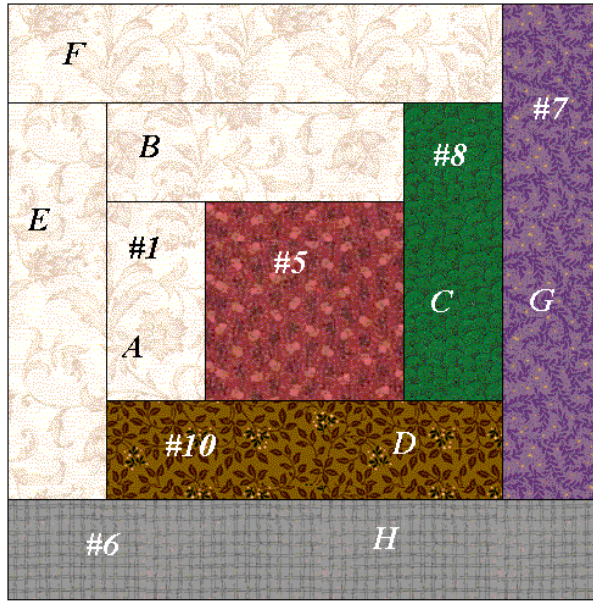
Begin by piecing the “A” background piece to the center #5 Red square. Flip open and press seam allowance away from the center square. Add the next “B” background piece. Continue working your way around the center square in a clockwise direction.

Follow the alphabetical order shown on the illustrations on the next page. Make 6 blocks of each color scheme for a total of 12 blocks.

Your blocks should measure 12 ½” unfinished.
