Cutting Instructions (for all):

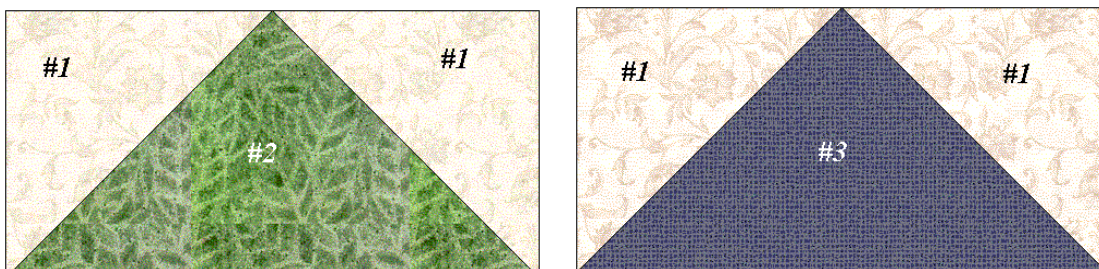
*******Bonus Clue:** The majority of these units are used for border sections. If you desire, you may choose solid fabric border sections to save time. However, some units are necessary for the main body of your quilt top. (See cutting directions below).

Color #1 Background	Border: Cut 104 – 3 7/8” Squares	Main: Cut 16 – 3 7/8” Squares
Color #2 Lt. Green	Border: Cut 13 – 7 1/4” Squares	Main: Cut 2 – 7 1/4” Squares
Color #3 Blue	Border: Cut 13 – 7 1/4” Squares	Main: Cut 2 – 7 1/4” Squares

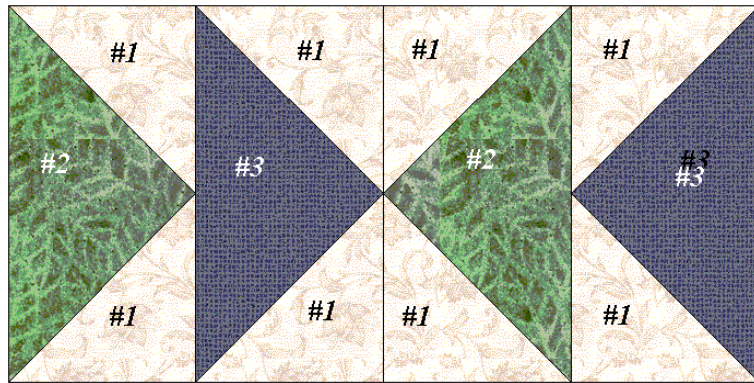
Assembly:

Make no-waste flying geese units using #2 Lt. Green/Background pieces and #3 Blue/Background pieces.

For the main body of your quilt, you will need 8 units each color (2 sets of 4). For the border sections, you will need 52 units each color (13 sets of 4).

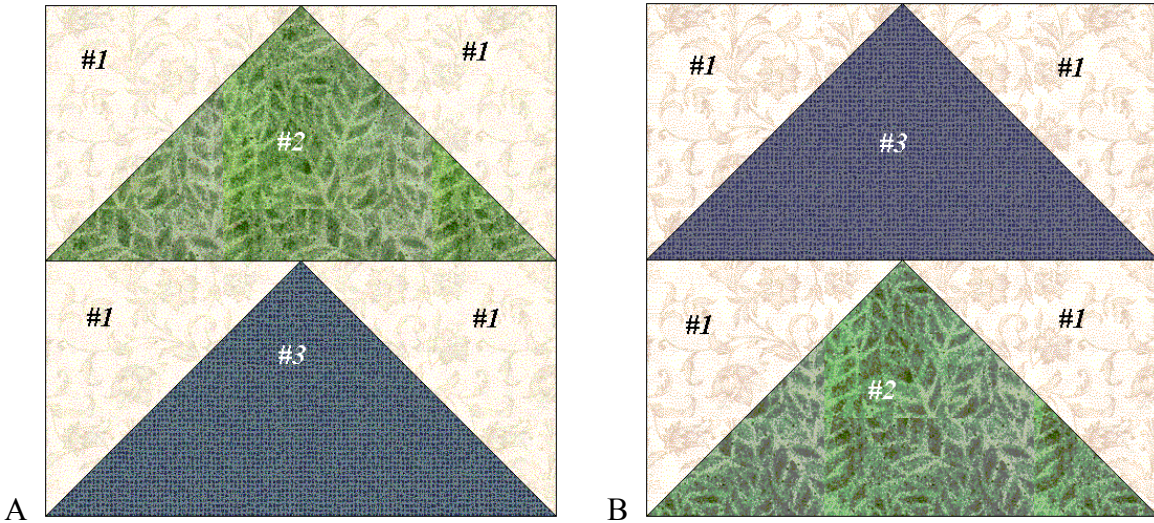


For the main body of your quilt top, assemble the following units. Make 4 units. They should measure 6 1/2” x 12 1/2” unfinished.

With the remaining flying geese units, assemble them in pairs as follows: (Note Color Arrangements)



You will have 26 of each “A” & “B”. Your blocks should measure 6 ½” unfinished.
