



Regina's Quilt Block

This 9" finished block is dedicated to my best friend and quilter extraordinaire, Regina Mann. She was very fond of anything green or purple. And a combination of both was her favorite. She was a great inspiration to me and I consider it a privilege to have spent many, many unforgettable years quilting with her.

Cutting Instructions:

Lavender Background:

Cut 2 – 3 7/8" Squares, Cut once on the Diagonal

Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles

Cut 1 – 2 7/8" Square, Cut Once on the Diagonal, (Use one and save one for the next block)

Spring Green:

Cut 1 – 4 1/4" Square, Cut Twice on the Diagonal

Cut 1 – 3 1/4" Square, Cut Twice on the Diagonal, (Use one and save 3 for future blocks)

Dark Purple:

Cut 1 – 4 1/4" Square, Cut Twice on the Diagonal

Cut 1 – 3 1/4" Square, Cut Twice on the Diagonal, (Use one and save 3 for future blocks)

Dark Green:

Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles

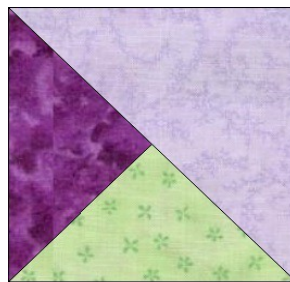
Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Rectangles

Assembly:

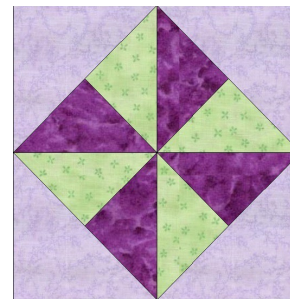
Begin by forming units with your large Dark Purple & Spring Green triangles. Make 4 units and join as shown.



Make 4 units as shown

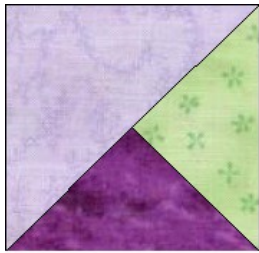


Add Lavender triangles as shown

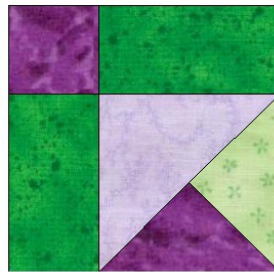


Join units as shown

Create the corner unit next:



Make 1 unit per block



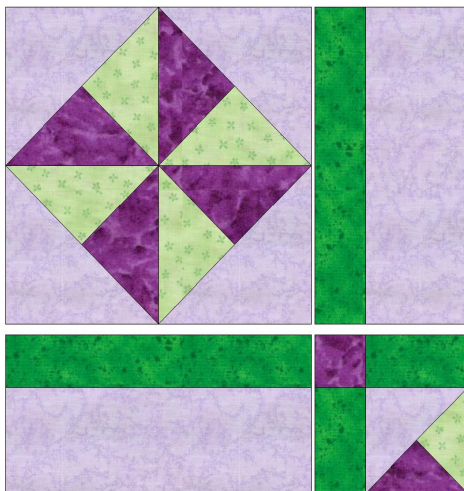
Add the Small Dark Green Rectangles and the Dark Purple Square as Shown

Create side units by joining long lavender rectangles and long dark green rectangles.

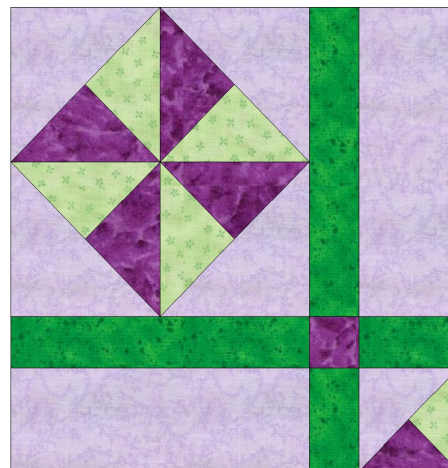


Make 2 units per block from the Long Green Rectangles and the Lavender Rectangles as shown.

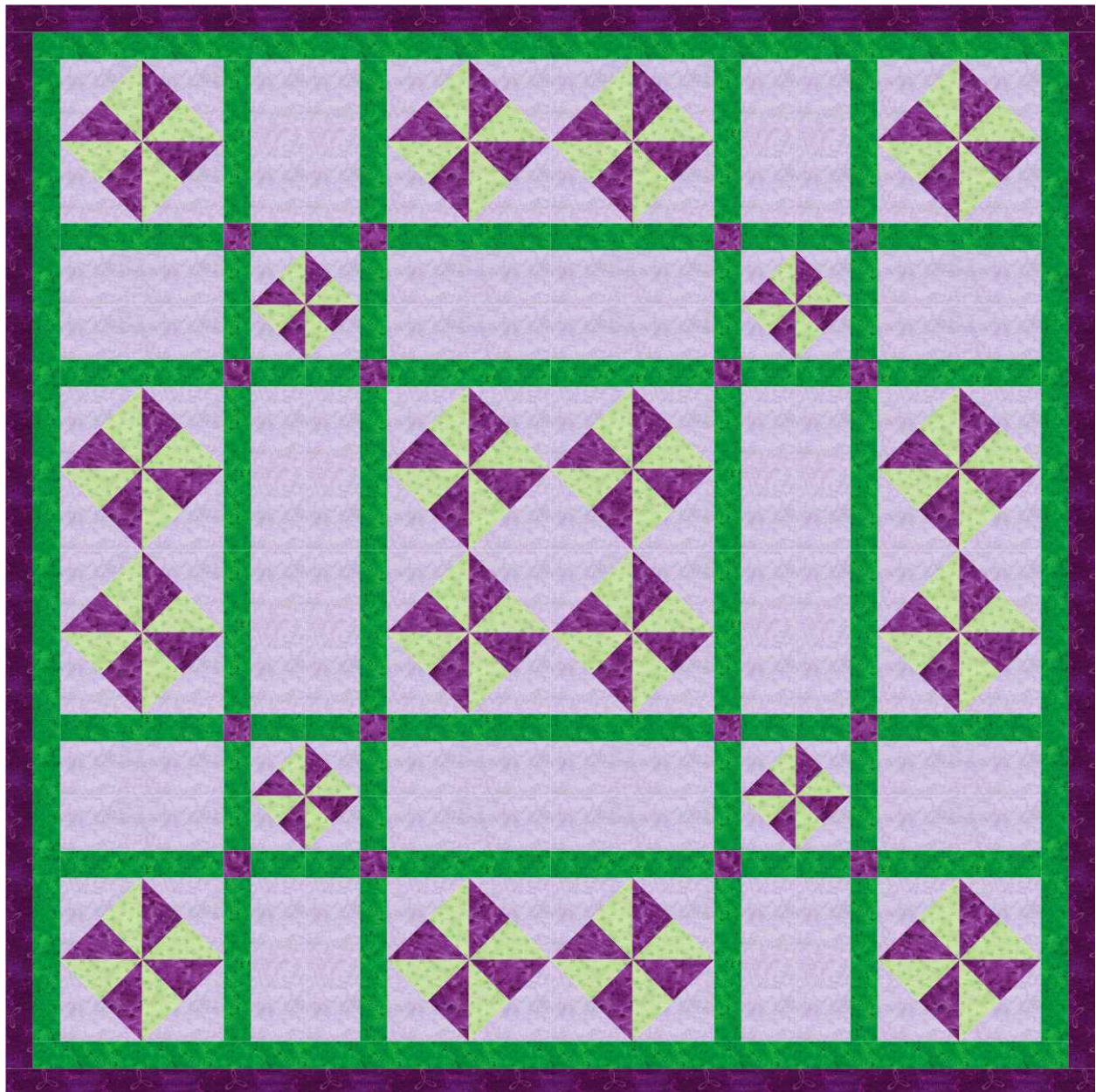
Then assemble your units to form the block:



Join as shown



Here's a possible layout you might consider for your quilt.
This layout uses 4 rows of 4 blocks each.
It measures 36" x 36" before borders of your choice.
