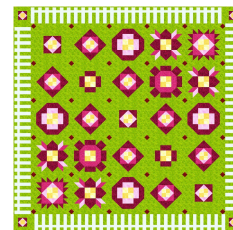

Roses Are Red 63" x 63"

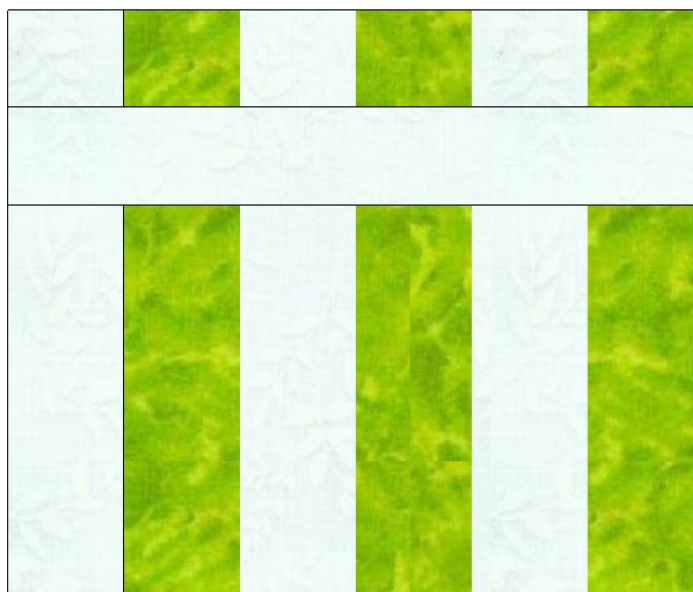
Picket Fence Borders

Cutting Instructions for 1 block: (YOU WILL NEED TO MAKE 32 BLOCKS)

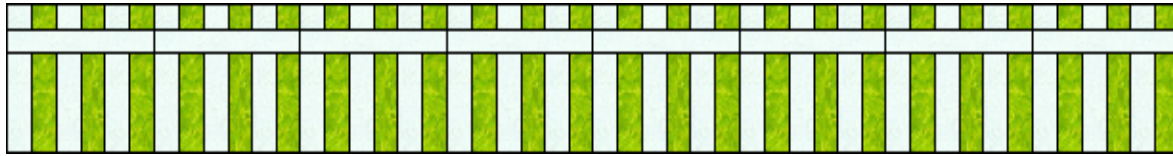
<i>Background</i>	Cut 3 – 1 ½" x 1 ¼" Rectangles Cut 3 – 1 ½" x 3 ½" Rectangles
<i>White</i>	Cut 3 – 1 ½" x 1 ¼" Rectangles Cut 3 – 1 ½" x 3 ½" Rectangles Cut 1 – 1 ¼" x 6 ½" Rectangle

Assembly:

Join White & Background Green 1 ¼" x 1 ½" rectangles as shown for the top section of your block. Then join the White & Background Green 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles as shown for the bottom section. Join both sections with the long White rectangle as shown. Your block should measure 5" x 6 ½" unfinished.

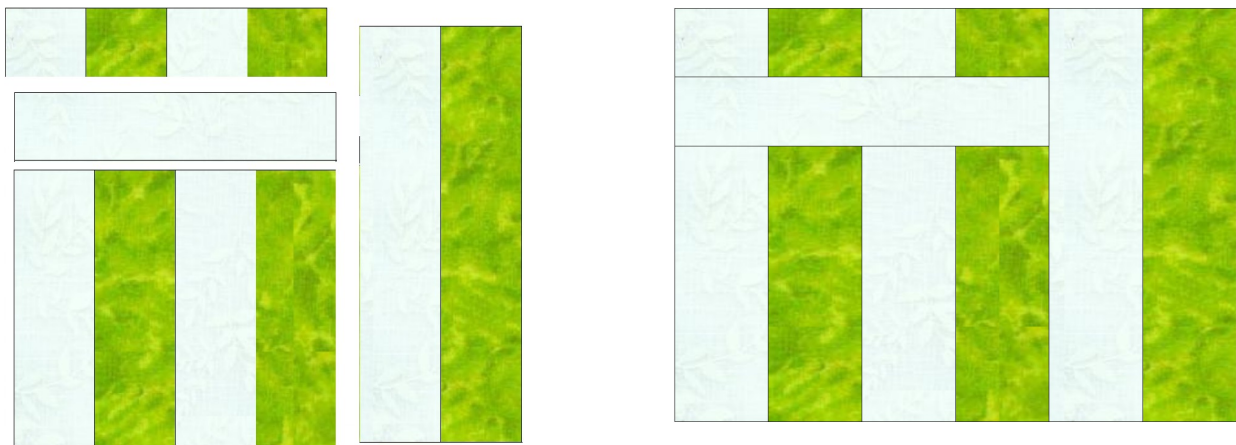


Join blocks end to end in 4 strips of 8 blocks each as shown:

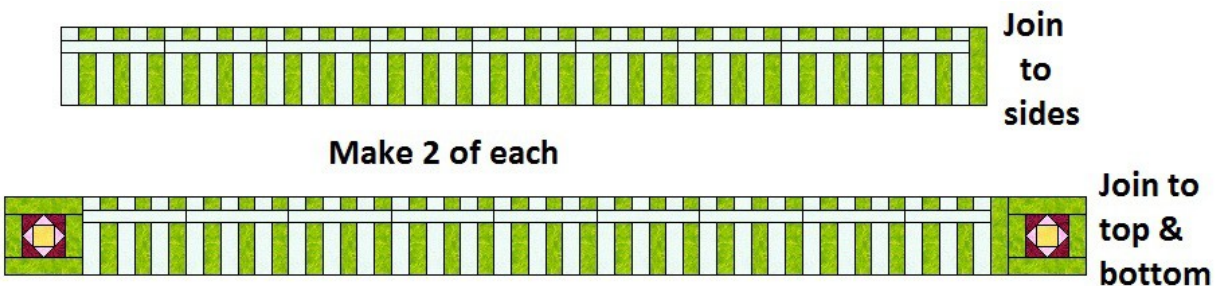


Now join an end block to the right end of each strip as follows: (Make 4)

<i>Background Green</i>	Cut 2 – 1 ½” x 1 ¼” rectangles Cut 2 – 1 ½” x 3 ½” rectangles Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 5” rectangle
<i>White</i>	Cut 2 – 1 ½” x 1 ¼” rectangles Cut 2 – 1 ½” x 3 ½” rectangles Cut 1 – 1 ¼” x 4 ½” rectangle Cut 1 – 1 ½” x 5” rectangle

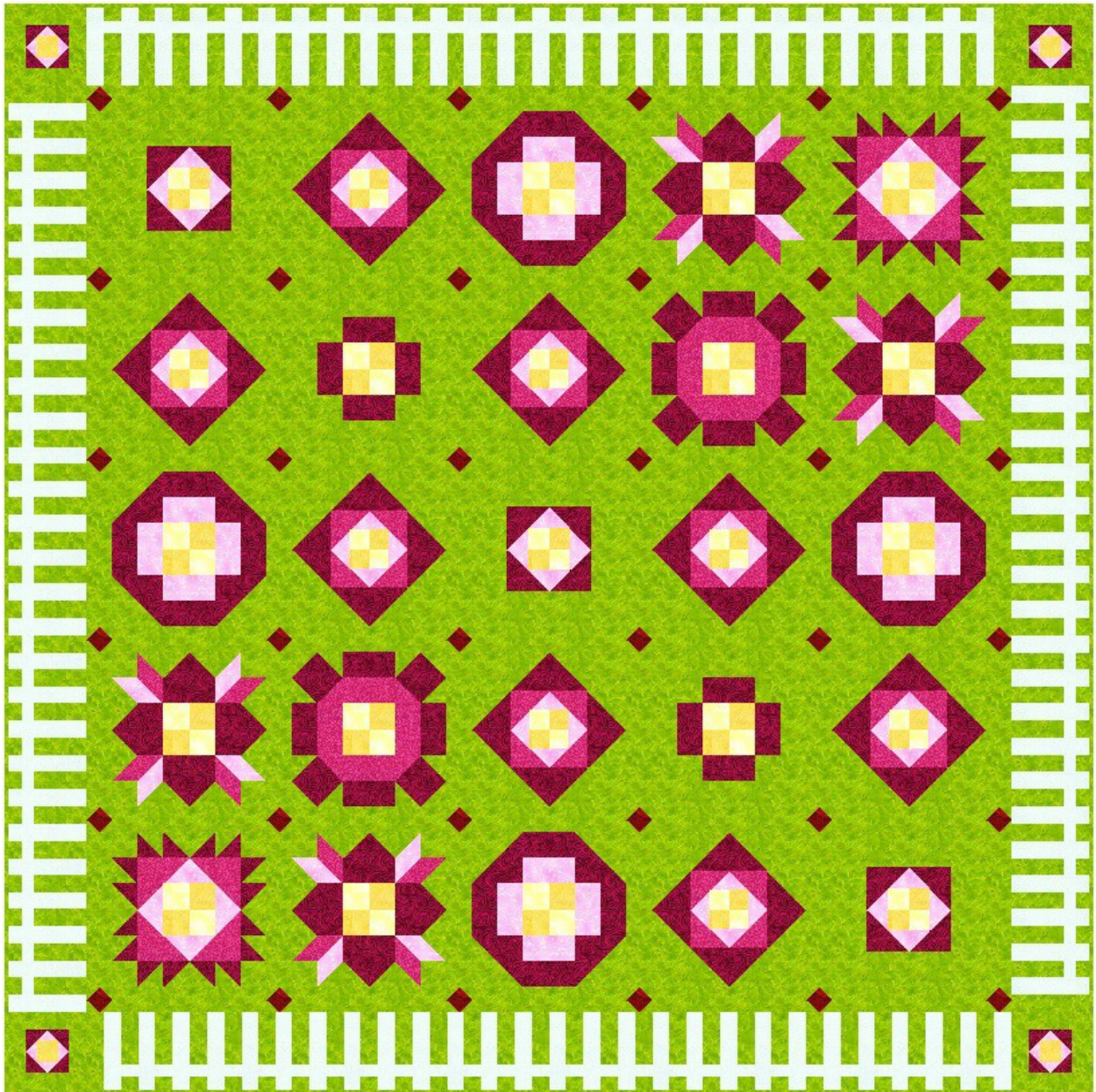


Add your end block to the right end of each of your border strips. Add a Corner Rose Block you had set aside previously to each end of 2 of your border strips as shown:



Join to the sides of your quilt center. Then join the strips with corner blocks to the top and bottom.

Quilt as Desired.
Bind with 7 strips background green (2 ¼" x WOF).
