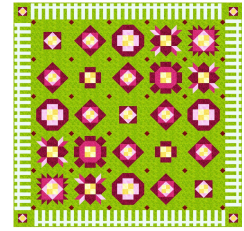

6th Rose

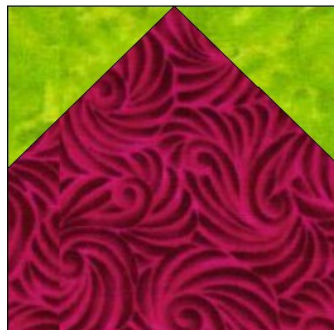
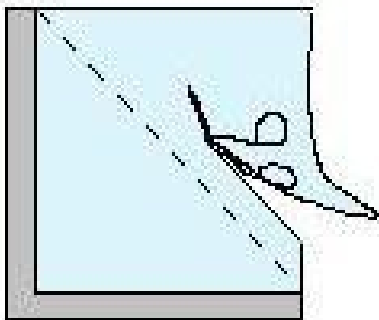
Cutting Instructions for 1 block: (YOU WILL NEED TO MAKE 4 BLOCKS)

<i>Background</i>	Cut 12 – 2" Squares, Mark 8 on the Diagonal for Quick Corners (4 remaining) Cut 4 – 2 ½" Squares for HST's
<i>Yellow Scraps</i>	Cut 4 – 2" Squares
<i>Light Pink</i>	Cut 4 – 2 ½" Squares, Mark on the Diagonal for HST's
<i>Medium Pink</i>	Cut 4 – 2 ½" Squares, Mark on the Diagonal for HST's
<i>Deep Red</i>	Cut 4 – 3 ½" Squares

Assembly:

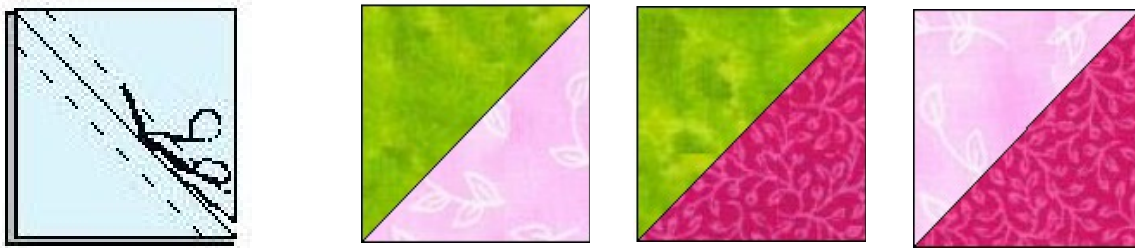
Quick Corner Piecing:

Using a Red 3 ½" Square, place a Background (Green) 2" square on the upper right corner. Place the diagonal line you marked in the proper direction and sew on the marked line. Trim away ¼" from that line as shown. Flip out and press. Repeat this on an adjacent corner. You will have 2 Background corners on each red square. You will create 4 units as shown.



Half-Square Triangle Piecing:

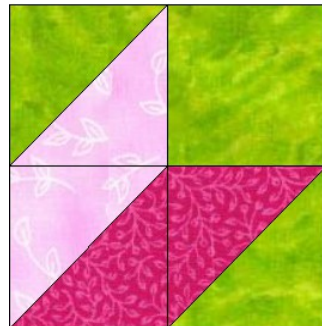
Right Sides together and using a Pink 2 ½” and a Background Green 2 ½” Square, stitch ¼” on both sides of the diagonal line you drew. Cut ON THE LINE, press seam allowance to the darkest side. **Trim down** to a 2” square unit. Makes 2 units as shown. Repeat once more for a total of 4 Pink/Green units.



Repeat for Medium Pink/Green HST's. (For a total of 4 units).

Repeat for Light Pink/Medium Pink HST's. (Also for a total of 4 units).

Join units as shown to form the 4 corner sections. Your sections should measure 3 ½”.



Continue piecing your block, rotating your corner units as shown. Your block will measure 9 1/2” unfinished
