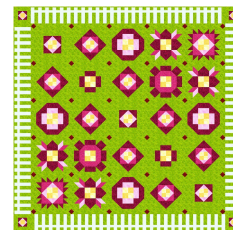


CLAUDIA'S QUILT SHOPPE



Roses Are Red 63" x 63"

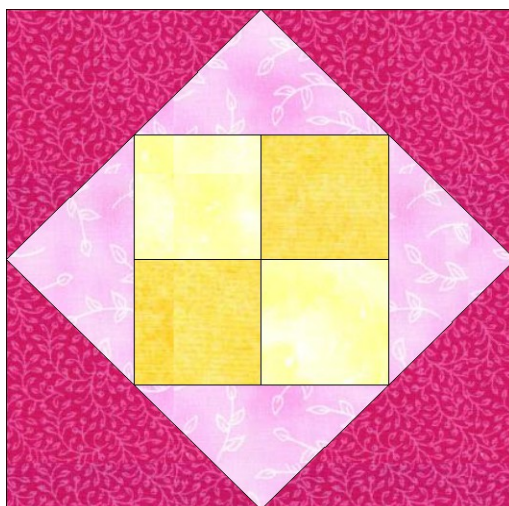
7th Rose

Cutting Instructions for 1 block: (YOU WILL NEED TO MAKE 2 BLOCKS)

<i>Background</i>	Cut 8 – 2 ½" Squares, Mark on the Diagonal for HST's Cut 4 – 2" Squares
<i>Yellow Scraps</i>	Cut 4 – 2" Squares
<i>Light Pink</i>	Cut 1 – 4 ¼" Square, Cut on BOTH Diagonals
<i>Medium Pink</i>	Cut 2 – 3 7/8" Squares, Cut Once on the Diagonal
<i>Deep Red</i>	Cut 8 – 2 ½" Squares for HST's

Assembly:

Create center section working from the center outward as before. Join light pink triangles to center squares, then join medium pink triangles. Your center section should measure 6 ½".

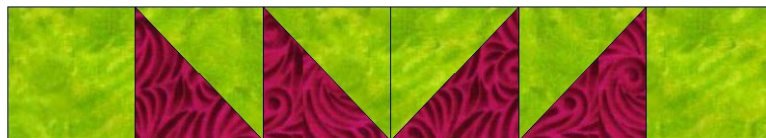


Half-Square Triangle Piecing:

Right Sides together and using a Red 2 ½” and a Background Green 2 ½” Square, stitch ¼” on both sides of the diagonal line you drew. Cut ON THE LINE, press seam allowance to the darkest side. This yields 2 HST units. **Trim down** to a 2” square unit. Repeat for the remaining red and green 2 ½” squares. You will have a total of 16 HST units.



Join units as shown to form outer sections.



Add to center section as shown. Your block will measure 9 ½” unfinished.
